**WEATHER SUMMARY:** See attached Fire Weather Forecast

Hot, dry, windy conditions which have persisted for the past several days will diminish this afternoon. Winds will subside with a slow change in the pattern to a light SW-W flow over the next several days.

**Max Temp:** around 75°

**Min RH:** 15%

**Slope Winds (20'):** W to 10 mph, possible gusts to 15

**Ridgetop Winds:** SE to 10

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**General Fire Behavior for the Grass Valley and Slide Fires:**

Gusty N-NE winds will continue through the morning and subside early afternoon switching more westerly.

**Specific Fire Behavior:**

For both fires the potential worst-case fire behavior during the morning will be ROS of 10-20 chains/hour, flame lengths of 6-10 feet for a surface fire but can be significantly increased during torching/short crown runs in brush or tree canopies, probability of ignition up to 60%, and spotting distance to ½ mile.

During the afternoon fire behavior on the majority of the fire will diminish to a ROS of 3-10 chains/hour, flame lengths of 3-5 feet, probability of ignition 60%, spotting distance ¼ mile or less.

In the Old Fire burn area the fuel model changes to a grass-type. Expect ROS of 15-30 chains/hour, flame lengths 5-7 feet, probability of ignition 60%, spotting distance ¼ mile or less.

### AIR OPERATIONS:

Winds should be diminishing allowing better aircraft utilization unless reduction in visibility due to smoke becomes an issue.

### SAFETY

Keep heads-up for burning out materials (snags) and rolling materials dislodged by burn-out including rocks. Watch-out for rapid rates of spread in grass fuel types (Old Fire burn).
