GENERAL: What was predicted and what actually happen was different due to the high level moisture over the fire by mid day. This increase in RH's yesterday allowed for a reduction in fire behavior. The weak high pressure that was expected to develop over the area has also diminished. For the next couple of days conditions will continue to favor low fire behavior activity and allow for low fireline intensities. No unusual runs or torching is expected today.

FUELS: Live fuels are critically low due to drought impacts on the vegetation; Most of this fire is burning in vegetation that has not burned in over 50 years. Old burns are not containing fire spread. Expect fires to continue to actively spread in these old burns

WEATHER: Low pressure trough off the coast will produce locally gusty winds and will persist out of the SSW

TOPOGRAPHY: This higher elevation fire has little opportunity to make long canyon runs due to it location on top of the San Bernardino Mountains. Small runs are still possible where slope and continuous fuels are in alignment

BRANCH I

Great suppression effort on hotspots located next to and near the fire perimeter has greatly reduced flare-up and torching potential from this backing fire that would have the potential to spread downslope. Fire behavior will consist of burnout of the remaining heavy concentrations of fuels. Alignment of this south facing slope will show an increase in fire behavior earlier in the day especially in the interior of the burn.

BRANCH II

During an aerial recon yesterday, there was one detectable smoke along the handline that may flare-up with gusty SSW winds. A tremendous suppression effort in this area of the fire has greatly reduced the amount and intensity of fire. The expected fire behavior in this area will be limited to heavy ground fuels under the mixed conifer that continues to burnout. Interior isolated torching is still possible where crews find terrain inaccessible.

BRANCH III

Much of this area where the fire burned through is very scabby and hard to detect a true fire edge. Most of what remains from Heaps Peak north to the Boy Scout camp will consist of ground fire heavy fuels continuing to burnout along with some small pockets of continuous understory fuels. Hotspots along the edge of the fireline will continue to persist until burned out or mopped up. No anticipated increase in fire behavior from what was observed yesterday.

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke volume has greatly diminished allowing for clear air most of the day.
