We have received your October 2, 2015 request for Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) for the Woodrat Fire on the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forest. We approve funding \$78,175 to implement treatments for weeds, roads, the listed protection and safety measures, and the weeds treatment effectiveness monitoring. All treatment must be completed within one year of fire containment. The fund code H1J1PF16 0117 will be established for the following parts of the request:

The fire was 95 percent contained on September 2, 2015 with minor fire activity expected until snow begins to fall. However, for administrative purposes the RO considers the current containment a sufficient benchmark from which to complete all authorized treatments within one year of this approval date. Additional direction on the standards and procedures for emergency actions are found in ID-2520-2013-1 and FSH 2509.13.

Funds are currently available for the project, but could be restricted later. If this happens you will be contacted by the Regional Budget Officer regarding specific spending restrictions and procedures.

If implementation identifies the need for additional resources, an interim request can be submitted. Include revised cost estimates, needs, and a brief report of accomplishments to date. Please send final FS-2500-8, describing treatments completed and associated costs, within 60 days after completing treatments. As a reminder, we need all accomplishments reported in the applicable reporting system.
