<p>Mop-up is looking good on the west, south and east sides of the incident. The most concentration of isolated heat sources is still located in the central part of the incident. The fire is located north of Reeves Creek, west of Eight Dollar Mountain, South East of Lake Selmae County Park and south of Deer Creek.</p> <p>To Note: 2.7 miles West of the incident some isolated heat sources were detected at Josephine Campground, which is located on the south side of Eight Dollar Mountain, west side of Josephine Creek, on the NF-4201 road.</p>
