Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: There was no detectible growth of the heat perimeter. There are large concentrations of isolated heat in both the Western side and the Southeastern portions of the fire. There numerous isolated heat sources throughout the fire. There were no isolated heat sources outside the heat perimeter. There are many isolated heat sources within 500-feet of the Western perimeter and also a few in the most Southwest corner of the fire. The fire is still South of the power lines across the North Umpqua River, West of Bob Butte, East of Britt Creek, and just North of Bob Creek.
