Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Two heat sources were detected outside of the perimeter but these were within the burn out. They are identified on the map. No other heat sources were detected outside of the perimeter. Increased acres primarily due to the burnout east of Beaverdam Creek. Very slight changes to the heat perimeter otherwise. Intense heat detected along the burnout. Scattered heat remains in the southern portion of the fire along Columbus Creek and Hardscrabble Ridge, and along the burnout. Isolated heat sources were detected throughout.
