Forest Order No. 01-04-08-15-011

National Forest System Area Closure

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter II, Part 261, Subpart B, Section 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the Priest Lake Ranger District within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests:

Being on or using the following area (National Forest System lands) within Kaniksu Complex Closure:

All or portions of the following sections are being closed:

State of Idaho:

T60N, R5W, Sections: 18, 19, 30, 31, 32

T59N, R5W, Sections: 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 30

State of Washington:

T36N, R45E, Sections: 32, 33, 34, 35.

T35n, R45E, Sections: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, 35, 36.

T34N, R45E, Sections: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36.

T33N, R45E, Sections: 1, 2, 11, 12, 13.

T35N, R46E, Sections: 7, 18, 19, 30, 31.

T34N, R46E, Sections: 6, 7, 18, 19, 30, 31.

T33n, R46E, Sections: 6, 7, 18.

Being in the Kaniksu Complex is defined by National Forest System lands located within the following boundaries (36 CFR 261.52(e)):

The portion of the Priest Lake Ranger District beginning at intersection of Boswell Kings Lake Road 305 and Idaho Panhandle/Colville National Forest boundary, east along Boswell Kings Lake Road 305 to the intersection with forest road 2730, then northeast along Goose Creek to Goose Creek Road 333, continue northeast on Goose Creek Road 333 to the intersection with Squaw Valley Mill Creek Road C-312, then north along the section line between T59N, R5W, Section 16/17, 8/9, 4/5 to Binarch Creek, then northwest along Binarch Creek to the intersection with Lamb Creek Connection Road 219, then north along Lamb Creek Connection Road 219 to the intersection with Lamb Creek Road 310, the northwest along Lamb Creek Road 310 to the intersection with Stateline Trail 169, then northwest along Stateline Trail 169 to Idaho Panhandle/Colville forest boundary at Hungry Horse, then south along the forest boundary to Boswell Kings Lake Road 305, the point of beginning.

Being on the following Forest Roads (36 CFR 261.54(e)):

Forest Roads: #305 (from the intersection with the Idaho Panhandle/Colville National Forest boundary to the junction of Forest Road 2730), #333, #219, #310 (from the intersection of forest road #219 to Gleason Mountain) northwest to Gleason Mountain), #219, #312, #1096, #305 (from the junction of Forest Road #1098 to the administrative Forest boundary between the Idaho Panhandle National Forests and the Colville National Forest).

Being on Forest Trails (36 CFR 261.55(a)):

Trail #197, Trail #164, Trail #162 and Trail #220.

This restriction is in addition to those stated in Subpart A, 36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 261 and becomes effective September 9, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

This restriction is necessary for the protection of public health and safety during (36 CFR 261.53(e)) Wildfire Activity.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following individuals are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
