Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: GISS Skip provided an approximate perimeter. As it was larger than had heat and due to topography and vegetation seen in orthoimagery mapped the heat perimeter less than the provided estimated perimeter. (including the estimated perimeter grown out in the few spots as well in a separate zip file). One possible spot in W¼ sect 28 T28N R87W in a draw. Within heat perimeter west half is mainly scattered heat from western edge up Post Draw and it's side slopes. Some intense heat along east edge and small area center with scattered heat between. A couple isolated heat signatures in Dry Tensleep draw and two west along a two track road in sec 22, one in sec 27 at top of slope. All isolated points have a lat/long in the attribute table.
