Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonights imagery was great for accurate mapping of the perimeter and heat sources.

The fire showed some Intense heat as the perimeter expanded about 80 acres on the western side, and about 10 acres expanded along the southeast side, and 10 acres as the big spot fire on the northeast side of the fire expanded slightly uphill towards the main fire.

The rest of the fire shows reduced heat from last night and is mapped as scattered and isolated heats.
