


Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Buffered Waterways - Wyoming 2016

Index Page (dashed orange line)


Buffered Waterway (red line)

Buffer is one half mile upstream/downstream & 200 feet of riparian zone from point of detection

Species may include one or more of the following:
Asian Clam, Curly Pondweed, New Zealand Mudsail, Rusty Crayfish

Although considered pervasive throughout Wyoming waterways, Whirling Disease is not reflected on these maps and should be considered as part of a comprehensive AIS control program.
