Explanation of Terms and Abbreviations

Bankhead Jones Acquired Land - Refers to land acquired by the federal government under the Bankhead Jones Farm Tenant Act of 1937. These lands were acquired for agricultural purposes and became the foundation of the National Grasslands. In Wyoming, most of these lands are located in the Thunder Basin National Grassland and managed by USFS, with a small amount managed by BLM outside the grassland boundary.

BLM - Bureau of Land Management

BOR - Bureau of Reclamation

COE - US Army Corps of Engineers

Designated Wild & Scenic River Corridors - 1/4 mile buffers of stream segments designated by Congress as part of the National Wild and Scenic River System.

DOD - Department of Defense

Local Government Lands - Lands owned and/or managed by local government entities including county and municipal governments, school districts, community colleges, irrigation districts, conservation districts, and other special districts.

NPS - National Park Service

OSLI - Wyoming Office of State Lands and Investments

PHMA - Sage Grouse Priority Habitat Management Areas (based on Core Area Version 3)

USFS - US Forest Service

USFWS - US Fish & Wildlife Service

WGFD - Wyoming Game & Fish Department

Wind River Indian Reservation Tribal Lands - Lands owned by the Arapaho and Shoshoni Tribes, managed with assistance from the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
