Manage the fire(s) within the swamp under a surveillance/containment strategy in accordance with suppression actions recommended in the WFSA. Contain the fire to the area north of SR 2; east of Swamp Road in Ware County; south and west of US Hwy 1 and the CSX Railroad line; and within the Perimeter Road, monitoring fire advance within the swamp interior in Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. 4. Protect key resources including threatened and endangered species and their habitat, over-night canoe shelters, and other resources. 5. Protect the integrity of the Okefenokee Wilderness. 6. Manage the fire(s) in a cost effective and efficient manner commensurate with estimates developed in the WFSA.

FORECAST ISSUED: 05/11/2007

WEATHER DISCUSSION: There will be a slight chance of a thunderstorm this afternoon. A cold front is expected to move through the complex Sunday. This will create a good chance of showers and thunderstorms.

The main concern is:

1. Low Humidity and wind gusts around 15 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Saturday:

WEATHER: Becoming Partly Cloudy with a 20% chance of an afternoon thunderstorm.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 90 (24 hour trend = 1 deg higher)

MIN HUMIDITY: 32-37 percent (24 hour trend ~ 3-5 percent lower)

20 FT WINDS: East Northeast at 5 to 10 mph with gusts around 15 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion setting up to 1000 feet dissipating by 0930. Mixing heights around 7000 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index around 32. Haines Index 4 (low).

WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Saturday night:

WEATHER: Mostly Clear.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 63-66. (24 hour trend = No change)

MAX HUMIDITY: Recovery to 75 percent near the fire and around 95 percent elsewhere.

20 FT WINDS: East 3-5 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion setting up to 1000 ft dissipating by 0800. Dispersion Index around 2.

OUTLOOK FOR Sunday: Increasing clouds with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Chance of rain 50%. High temperatures 83 to 86. Minimum RH values 43 to 45 percent. North wind 8 to 12 mph gusts 20 mph.

SUNRISE/SUNSET: Saturday May 12th...0636/2013

- * Aircraft Operations:** When in the area of aircraft operations, remain heads up to the action. Don't get too close. Remember, it is easier for you to move out of the way on the ground than it is for the pilot to see and avoid you.
- * Critters:** Snakes, alligators, ticks, chiggers, black flies, etc. Use protective sprays and watch where you step. Don't feed the alligators under any circumstances.
 - **Structure Protection:** There are many structures in and around the fire. A quick review of pages 16 and 17 in your IRPG would be a good tailgate safety meeting before you get started. Also, watch for power lines and other hazards as you plan your defense.
