**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A cold front is expected to move through the complex Sunday. This will create a chance of showers and thunderstorms.

The main concern is:

1. Increasing wind speeds with afternoon gusts 20 to 25 mph. Erratic and gusty winds in the the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.

---

**WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Sunday:**

**WEATHER:** Becoming Mostly Cloudy with a 40% chance of an thunderstorm.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 85 (24 hour trend = 5 deg lower )

**MIN HUMIDITY:** 35-40 percent (24 hour trend ~ 3 to 5 percent higher)

**20 FT WINDS:** North to Northeast 10 to 15 mph with gusts around 20 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Mixing heights around 6000 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index around 16. Haines Index 2 (very low).

**WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Sunday night:**

**WEATHER:** Mostly cloudy with a 40 percent chance of evening showers with a possible thunderstorm decreasing to 20 percent chance of showers overnight.

**MIN TEMPERATURES:** 65. (24 hour trend = No change)

**MAX HUMIDITY:** Recovery to 75 percent near the fire and around 95 percent elsewhere.

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast 3-5 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion setting up to 500 ft dissipating by 0800. Dispersion Index around 5.

**\*Traffic:** We have discussed traffic and driving many times on this incident. As we continue to log many miles on the roads, we will keep hitting on this subject. If weather causes problems on the roads, such as the fog/smoke yesterday, slow your speed to match the conditions.
