Firefighters will not be deployed within the swamp to fight active fire. 2. Implement suppression actions as needed to protect private investments and improvements and facilities in Stephen Foster State Park. 3. Manage the fire(s) within the swamp under a surveillance/containment strategy in accordance with suppression actions recommended in the WFSA. Contain the fire to the area north of SR 2; east of Swamp Road in Ware County; south and west of US Hwy 1 and the CSX Railroad line; and within the Perimeter Road, monitoring fire advance within the swamp interior in Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge. 4. Protect key resources including threatened and endangered species and their habitat, over-night canoe shelters, and other resources. 5. Protect the integrity of the Okefenokee Wilderness. 6. Manage the fire(s) in a cost effective and efficient manner commensurate with estimates developed in the WFSA.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

A cold front will move into the area by this morning with a chance of showers and possible thunderstorms. High pressure will build into the area Friday and into the weekend.

The main concern: Thunderstorms with lightning strikes possible today.

WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Thursday:

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy with a 30 percent chance of showers and possible thunderstorms.

MAX TEMPERATURES: around 80 (24 hour trend = decrease of 8)

MIN HUMIDITY: 40 to 45 percent (24 hour trend = 10 to 15 percent higher)

20 FT WINDS: North 10 with gusts to 15 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Mixing heights around 4000 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index 20. Haines Index 3 (very low).

TRANSPORT WINDS: Northwest to north 10 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Thursday night:
