### WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Critical fire weather conditions due to low afternoon humidity may develop over the incident area this afternoon. Dry high pressure is centered to our north. As a result, anticipate low dewpoints with a light to moderate northeast surface wind. High pressure will prevail through the first half of next week.

The main concern: **Low Afternoon Humidity Today and Sunday.**

### WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Saturday:

**WEATHER:** Mostly sunny, breezy and dry.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** around 83 (24 hour trend = little change)

**MIN HUMIDITY:** 20 to 25 percent (24 hour trend = 5 percent lower)

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast 7 to 11 mph with gusts to 16 mph...shifting east after 1600 (4 PM).

Wind shift is due to anticipated arrival of sea breeze.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Mixing heights around 6500 ft in the afternoon.

Dispersion Index 55. Haines Index 5 (high).

**TRANSPORT WINDS:** Northeast 16 mph.

### WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Saturday night:

**WEATHER:** Clear. Areas of smoke around Fargo.

<p><b>All Divisions:</b> Continuing very low fuel moistures but somewhat lighter winds will reduce predicted spread rates and flame lengths from yesterday. However, active behavior will start earlier and will more likely approach the predicted maximums. Fire intensities and probabilities of ignition remain at yesterday's very high levels. Again, torching activity with head fires will be continuous, both in the swamp and pinelands, and frequent group torching will occur with flanking fire in the swamp.</p> <p><b>Structure:</b> Okefenokee administrative site is not likely to be impacted by fire spread during this operational period....</p> <p><b>IA:</b> Expect extreme behavior with fires establishing very quickly.</p>			
<b>AIR OPERATIONS:</b>			
Smoke may again limit operations before noon, but in the SW quarter of the fire today.			
<b>SAFETY:</b>			
With record-setting dryness in heavy fuels, be alert for deep (hot) ash pits and stump holes. <b>Predicted ERC for today is again 41.</b>
