

Along with other information (e.g., soils, topography) it is being used to rapidly develop estimates of post-fire risks of flooding and debris torrents, which will be used to prescribe post-fire mitigation activities. Some watersheds with important downstream values at risk near the fire are outlined on this map. Flooding will also depend on the location, intensity and duration of precipitation events and may vary widely and significantly.
